Minutes of the last meeting (Bisley, July 8/03) were adopted.

P.Harrison (GB) provided an overview of the International Rules Review Group

The following motions were passed for recommendation to the ICFRA Council;

- 1 Moved US,2nd SA “Each Country is to provide their own ammunition for use in the Veterans Team Match. The ammunition can be hand loaded or commercially produced.” (against GB,CI)
- 2 Moved US,2nd CI “Only 308 Win/7.62 mm ammunition of ICFRA specifications is to be used in the Veterans Team Match.”
- 3 Moved CI,2nd GB “The Veterans Individual World Championship be based on the aggregate of at least two ranges at each of 300,600,900,1,000 yds (or the metric equivalent) from the host countries’ championship program. Where possible, the longer ranges should be selected on the basis of when most veterans will be shooting shoulder to shoulder. The ranges/matches selected for the aggregate are to be determined at least one year in advance of the event.”
- 4 Moved C,2nd SA “the 2015 Veterans World Championships be held in conjunction with the ICFRA/Palma Championships.”

The following motion was defeated;

- 1 The cut off date for eligibility be 60 years of age during the calendar year of the competition.

Mick Barr of Great Britain was elected Chairman of the Veterans Committee.
